4 - 3"x14" strips of fabric (can be 4 different or 2 each of 2 fabrics), it's OK if it's a little longer, extra jellyroll strips would work well for this even though they are a little smaller they will just result in a slightly smaller ornament

binding clips (optional)

tweezers (optional but recommended)

small scissors

thin ribbon or cording for hanger

2 - 6.5" squares of contrasting fabrics, fused wrong sides together

small cutting mat

rotary cutter

acrylic ruler

binding clips

white glue - Aileen's tacky glue or Elmer's white glue

2 buttons with no shank

thread & needle

thin ribbon or cording for hanger
